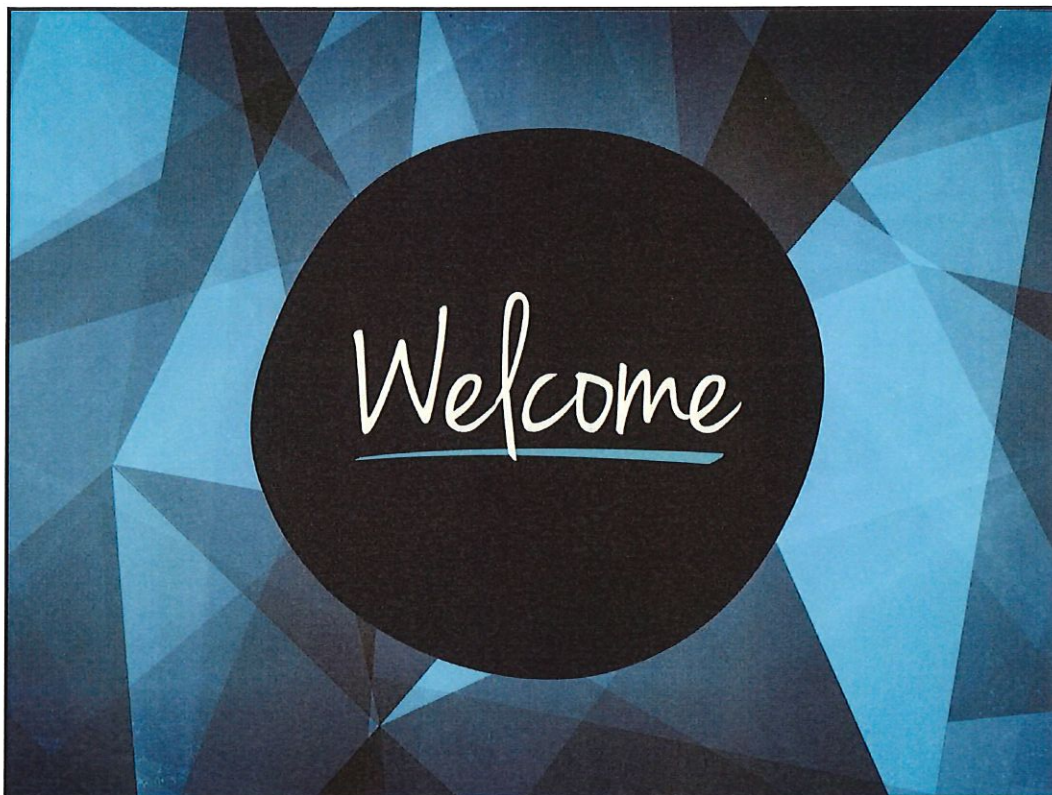

## REACH ONE

The mission of REACH one is to build relationships with youth that meaningfully imbed opportunities and experiences that help prepare them for life. REACH One currently has 30 mentoring groups, and is always looking for more volunteer mentors! We are also in the midst of creating a space in our new rental facility just for the mentors and mentee's to meet and do crafts, cook, and play games!

## MISSION BACKPACK

Mission Backpack is a program designed to supplement the nutritional needs of students in our schools. On the last day of the school week, students are given a bag that is filled with nonperishable food items, and monthly Kwik Trip vouchers are included which can be used for milk, eggs, bread, and bananas. On average last year we served 40 students. This number rose to 90 over the summer, but we expect to serve around 75 during the 20-21 school year.

## REACH RELIEF

REACH Relief's goal is to improve the health and well-being of under-resourced youth in our community by reducing obstacles that cause chronic stress, or impede their ability to learn, by providing access to community resources. Through December, REACH has expanded the program to include helping families overcome unexpected obstacles due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
