Jonathan serves with JAARS as a pilot in the Aviation Training Department while also assisting with the Aviation Engagement Team.

Since an early age, Jonathan has been fascinated by all things aviation. During high school he began taking flying lessons which led him to complete an undergraduate degree at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Aerospace Studies with minors in Logistics Aviation Maintenance and Business Administration. Several years after college he was led to change careers in aviation and join JAARS as a way to use his passion for aviation to serve those in need.

Originally assigned to a JAARS partner organization in South East Asia, a series of visa delays left him serving in Waxhaw before an opportunity to be loaned to Mission Aviation Fellowship came up. As part of that opportunity he flew with MAF's 135 program in Asia to support workers in some of the most remote places on earth. After finishing his term on loan to MAF, Jonathan returned stateside and accepted a position in the Aviation Training Department. During his transition back from overseas he also transitioned to flying helicopters to help meet a need for the organization.

When not on the road with the Aviation Engagement Team, Jonathan is often found working on automotive engineering projects as a holdover from a previous side career in professional motorsports. He is also likely to be found building custom aircraft simulators or working as a photographer.
